Integrated Business Planning workshop at CPO Agenda 100 Forum

Business Improvement specialists, Oliver Wight, are leading a workshop at this year's CPO Agenda Forum at RACV Royal Pines, Gold Coast, Australia on 30th August 2011.

The interactive workshop, which will be led by Oliver Wight Managing Partner, James Small, will demonstrate how integrated business planning (IBP) is essential for good category management.

Small will reveal how to bring demand management in line with consumer demand; how to forecast and plan end-to-end needs; and how to minimise links in the value chain.
